- Ceanothus 'Yankee Point' CN – Blue Flower
- Ceanothus prostrates CN –Blue Flower
- Ceanothus hearstorium CN –Blue Flower
- Grevillea lanigera 'Coastal Gem' – Pink Flower
- Salvia 'Dara's Choice' CN – Purple Flower
- Salvia spathacea CN – Rose Flower
- Coleonema 'Sunset Gold' – Yellow Flower

Medium sized Shrubs 3'-8'

- Leucodendron 'Safari Goldstrike' (requires sandy soils with good drainage) – Yellow Flower
- Leucodendron 'Yaelii'- Pink Tips



- Leucodendron 'Summer Red' – Red Tips

- Leucospermum 'Veldfire' – Orange Flower
- Grevillea victoriae – Red Flower
- Grevillea 'Canberra' – Pink Flower
- Choisya ternata – White Flower
- Choisya t. 'Sundance' – Yellowish/Green Shrub

- Myrica californica CN - Purple Fruit
- Drymis lanceolata 'Carmel Mtn. Lilac' – Red Stems
- Mahonia lomarifolia 'Chinese Holly' – Blue Berries
- Fremontodendron californica CN – Yellow Flower

Grass/ clumping plants 24-30"

- Mulinbergia rigens CN 'Deer Grass' – Long Stalks
- Festuca californica CN – Long Stalks
- Lomandra 'Breeze' – Small Yellow Flower
- Cordyline 'Festival Grass' – Burgundy Leaves
- Acorus 'Ogon' (shade/semi shade) – Yellow Leaves

- *Libertia peregrinis* – Orange Leaves

Large grass like foliage plants 3'-15'

- *Cordyline australis* – Palm-Like Plant
- *Cordyline 'Red Sensation'* – Burgundy Leaves
- *Cordyline 'Electric Pink'* – Pink Leaves
- *Chondropetalum tectorum* – Reed-Like Plant
- *Daslirion longissimum* – Very Long Leaves
- *Xanthorrhoea australis (pressii)* – Tall Flower Stalk
- *Phormium 'Yellow Wave'* – Yellow Leaves

Small succulents 12-30"

- *Cistanthe 'Jazz Time'* – Purple Flower
- *Aeonium 'Sunburst'* – Green, White, & Pink Leaves



- *Aeonium* sp.
- *Aloe striata 'Coral Aloe'* – Orange Flower
- *Aloe saponaria 'Soap Aloe'* – White Dots on Leaves
- *Agave victoriae* – Leaves Bordered in White
- *Echeveria 'Afterglow'* – Purple Leaves
- *Sedum* sp.
- *Dudleya* sp.
- *Aloe spinosissimum 'Spider Aloe'* – Orange Flower

Medium sized succulents 3'-6'

- *Agave vilmoriana* – Long Twisting Leaves
- *Agave attenuate* – Long Curved Flower Stalk
- *Beshornia* sp.
- *Furcraea* sp.

Large succulents 6-12'

- *Aloe 'Hercules'* – Tree with Spiked Leaves
- *Aloe ferrox 'Cape Aloe'* – Red Flower

Small trees 15-20'

- *Cercis occidentalis* CN – Pink/Purple Flower



- *Cotinus coggyriana* – Pinkish Flower
- *Acer circinatum* CN
- *Arbutus unedo* – Strawberry Flower

Medium sized trees 20-40'

- *Arbutus menziesii* CN 'Madrone' – Red Bark
- *Arbutus 'Marina'* – Strawberry-Like Fruit
- *Aesculus californica* CN – White Flower
- *Azara microphylla 'Variegata'* – Tiny Leaves
- *Casuarina littoralis* – Pine-Like Needles/Leaves
- *Lyonothamnus asplenifolius* CN – Fern-Like Leaves
- *Melaleuca quinquenervia* – Paper-Like Bark
- *Pistachio chinensis* – Redish Orange Leaves in Fall



- *Ulmus parvifolia* – Mottled Bark

Large trees 40-100'

- *Populus fremontii* CN
- *Quercus agrifolia* CN
- *Platanus racemosa* CN
- *Cedrus deodara*
